1 SOFTWARE PREREQUISITES

- Internet Browsers:

At least one of the following browsers is needed

- Microsoft Edge, version - 89.0.774.54
- Google Chrome, version - 89.0.4389.90
- Internet Explorer 11

- Java

Only one of the following Java jdk installations is needed

- Red Hat OpenJDK 11.0.9
- Oracle JDK 11.0.9
- AdoptOpenJDK 11.0.9 (HotSpot)

- Microsoft Visual C++

Documentum needs Microsoft Visual C++ 2013 Redistributable installed in the client PC, versions x86 and x64 both are needed.

- Administrator Rights

Open Microsoft Edge



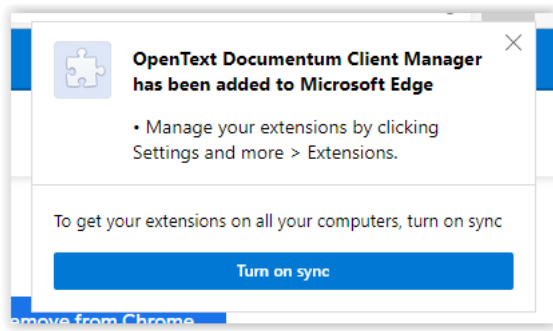
Add OpenText extension to Edge (the button shows Chrome, but it is Edge)



Allow execute changes (Administrator Rights)



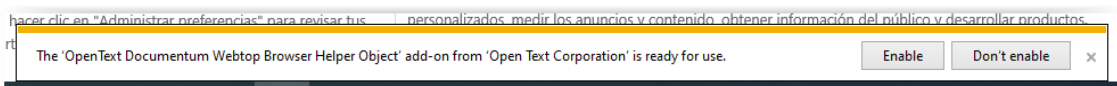

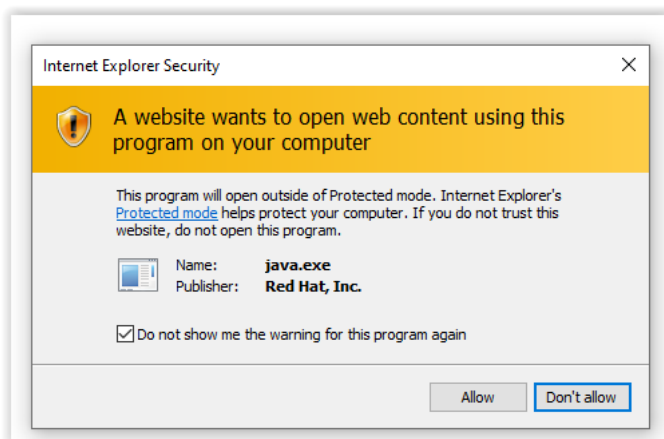

Click on “Enable”

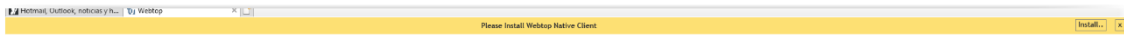

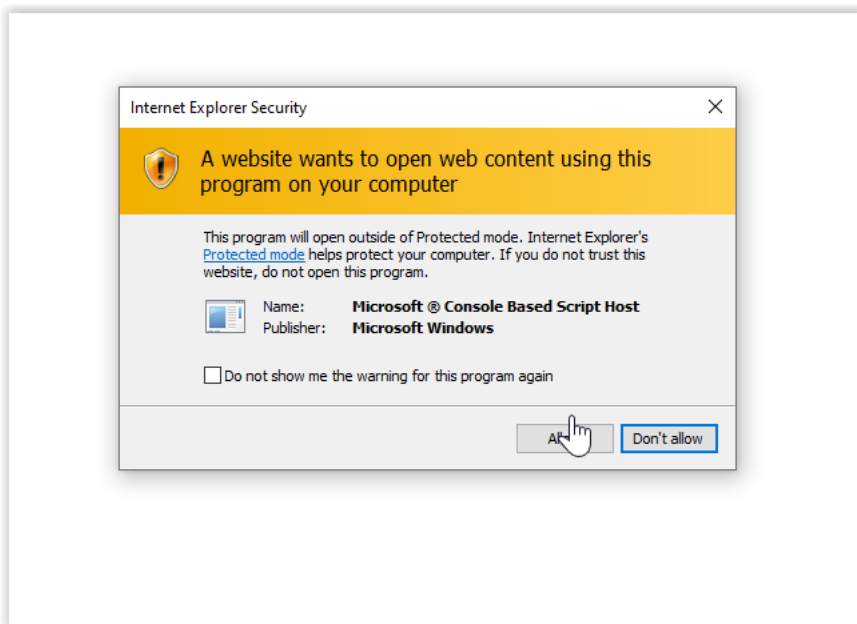
2.3.4 WdkPluginCab

Check Bowser top

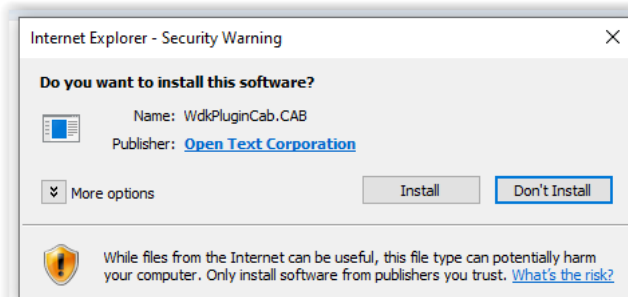
If the system needs to install WdkPluginCab.CAB, click on “Install”
